- 1. Write the following names in black at the appropriate locations on the map: Belfast, Cardiff, Cherbourg, Drogheda, Dublin, London, Monaghan\*, Montaigu, Nantes, Rennes.
- 2. Write the following names in black CAPITALS: Eire, England, France, Northern Ireland, Scotland, Wales.
- 3. Write the following names in blue at the appropriate locations on the map: The English Channel, The Irish Sea, The Atlantic Ocean
- 4. Colour the national and EU flags. Write the names IN ENGLISH of the two Irish national symbols on the document.
- 5. Colour The Republic of Ireland (Eire) green for the lowlands and brown for the uplands (check in an atlas). Colour Northern Ireland orange.
- 6. Calculate the distance from Montaigu to Monaghan\*, as the crow flies, both in kilometres and in miles.
- 7. Calculate the time spent on the ferry on the outward voyage (NB there is an hour's time difference between France and The UK and Ireland).
- 8. Indicate by a dotted line the route taken during the journey. NB The ferry will sail west of Lands End, but east of the Scilly Isles.
